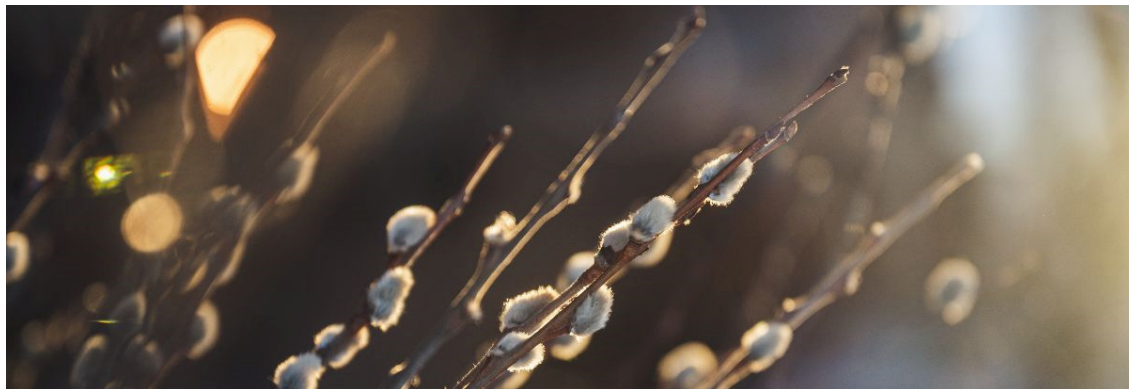


HILAH AYERS

Unfortunately, a lease fee increase was unavoidable due to rising fuel costs and record-high inflation. As a result, a \$200 per site premium has been introduced. Despite recent pleas, energy consumption continues to soar, so to preserve stagnant rates, we implore members and guests to be more mindful and considerate of usage. Although air conditioners have the highest amperage draw and should only be run when necessary, it is imperative to avoid all other nonessential applications. We are proud to offer ultra-competitive pricing, but we need your help to keep it that way.

The payment program of equal one-third installments will be available *upon*

request for the final time as we enter post-pandemic recovery. However, we strongly encourage lump sum remittances to alleviate the administrative strain that the collection process can create, as our efforts are better spent on activities and resort enhancements than chasing overdue accounts. Lease agreements will be distributed shortly via an eSignature service, along with an invoice outlining individual charges. The onsite food trailer will be operational again this season but under new management and will feature a delectable assortment of Indo-Canadian cuisine. Frank's Kitchen officially opens on Sunday, May 22nd. Furthermore, campground Wi-Fi activity has dwindled recently, attributed to greater data and mobile internet plan availability. Consequently, the pay-per-use network has been decommissioned by the third-party supplier.
