



With the camping season right around the corner, we are pleased to announce that lease rates will remain unchanged for the 2018 season (\$2,600 for 15-ampere sites and \$2,800 for 30-ampere sites, plus GST). A link to the current lease agreement is provided below. Review it thoroughly as a few revisions have been made, complete it as required, and return it along with payment by mail or in person prior to the start of the camping season (May 1st). The park office will reopen with regular business hours on April 15th. Alternatively, lot fees and completed contracts can be submitted electronically and sent to <a href="info@hilahayers.com">info@hilahayers.com</a>, but ensure that security answers for e-transfers are included. Security deposits are only required and applicable to new tenants, which

is \$1,000 and fully-refundable, so returning members should disregard line item number 4 of Schedule "A" as a result. For those wanting a copy of the countersigned lease agreement, specify accordingly. Finally, any outstanding balances that may exist including unpaid leasehold improvement overage fees, remote deposits, septic tank purchases, and interest should also be cleared off prior to the start of the camping season to avoid potential service interruptions. Account balances are available upon request. Current year upgrade assessments will be invoiced at the start of the season and tenants will again be afforded the summer to remit coinciding payments.

Finally, due to an uncharacteristically cold spring, power will not be restored earlier than the start of May and water supply will depend solely on ground thaw, but conditions are monitored closely and updates will be provided punctually. We are doing our very best to make preparations despite the inclement weather, but that certainly hasn't dampened our excitement for the fast approaching open.
