A volunteer committee is being assembled for the festival and a meeting will be held at the office at 1 o'clock this afternoon and we invite all interested individuals to join us to discuss the many positions that need to be filled for it and to appoint shifts. Those unable to attend are still very much welcome to help out, so please advise us of your availability and physical limitations if applicable, and we'll schedule your participation accordingly. Substantial support is needed throughout the course of this event in addition to the days leading up to it and various roles are

available to suit the strengths of each participant including those in hospitality, traffic/crowd control, ticket redemption, campsite assignment, merchandise sales, property preparations, and general assistance. Festival access and time afforded to actively partake in the festivities will be based on shift length and volunteer contributions. Longer shifts worked on Thursday and Friday will result in responsibility relinquishment over the weekend. Conversely, shifts on Saturday and Sunday are shorter, but time to enjoy notable musical performances will be somewhat sacrificed.

Due to the inevitable activity increase expected to be seen in and around the park, we vehemently urge all tenants, guest and festival attendees to take extra caution when operating a motor vehicle or equipment of any kind. A security detail will be enlisted to ensure personal safety is protected and all campground rules are abided by. There will be trained professionals to handle a plethora of situations so it is crucial that all urgent and disconcerting matters are reported to the office for proper assignment of responsibility. Wood deliveries will be halted over the long weekend so we strongly suggest submitting large orders as soon as possible; however, bundles will still be available at the office. Regular park hours remain in effect; therefore, be cognizant of site supplies and stock up when it is appropriate to do so. Finally, please ensure a remote is on you at all times as gates may stay open or closed unexpectedly to improve traffic and safety conditions.
